Priority Implementation Discussion.....Mr. Michaels

Mr. Michaels facilitated discussions on the implementation of the 2024-2027 SWDB Strategic Plan priorities, “Exploring an SC Works Partner Conference” and “Hosting SWDB/LWDB joint trainings, meetings, and information sessions.”

- *Exploring an SC Works Partner Conference:* The committee members discussed possible session topics and logistical requirements to host an in-person statewide conference for SC Works staffs, partners, and programs. Suggested session topics included the impact of artificial intelligence on the workforce and best practices in statewide strategic planning.
- *Hosting SWDB/LWDB joint trainings, meetings, and information sessions:* The committee members suggested trainings including building a high-performing workforce board, enhancing parliamentary and meeting procedures, and strengthening collaboration between state and local board executive leadership.

Utilizing the information from the implementation discussions, Staff will develop the framework for the SC Works Conference and provide an update during the Board Development Committee’s fourth quarter meeting.
