EXPUNGEMENT PAROLE & PARDON VIRTUAL INFORMATIONAL WORKSHOP

Expungement is the court-ordered process in which the legal record of an arrest, charge or conviction is erased from a person's criminal record. Get more information and ask questions virtually from your smartphone, laptop, or make an appointment at your local Goodwill Career Opportunity Center to use our computer workstations.

- Charged and arrested but not convicted (Non-Convictions)
- Completion of a Diversion Program
- Certain Misdemeanors
